Agency response

Interstate 35 runs through the center of Kearney with exits onto Missouri 92 Highway, where a large high-volume truck stop is located. Missouri Highway 33 and Missouri Highway 92 also run through Kearney and intersect with the Kearney City limits just east of Interstate 35. Within a five (5) mile radius of the Kearney City limits are a large number of subdivisions that have a population of more than 24,000 people. Most of these people drive through Kearney on a daily basis, using Interstate 35, Missouri 92 or Missouri 33.
