Agency response

The report prepared by the Attorney General's Office may provide an incomplete picture of traffic stop activities by the Joplin Police Department. The presence of large employment, retail, commercial and medical sites within Joplin results in a daily service population in excess of 225,000 people; five times greater than the resident population. Until valid data on the demographics of "the population of minority groups residing or traveling within the jurisdiction" is generated, comparisons of traffic stop data to local resident population demographics could easily lead to erroneous conclusions about law enforcement activities.
