Agency response

The Shrewsbury Police Department is committed to the fair treatment of all citizens and visitors of our community. We support the Missouri Attorney General's efforts to better understand traffic enforcement activity and patterns. However, since the data in the Attorney General's report is descriptive in nature and not interpretive, further analysis of traffic stops, arrests and searches is needed so that more meaningful interpretations of the data can be made. Race-neutral explanations need to be considered and ruled out before any possible conclusions relating to disparate treatment can be drawn. Furthermore, we believe it would be more prudent to examine traffic enforcement activity in terms of the population that travels upon a community's roadways rather than its resident population. This would allow the data to then be examined in a much more appropriate context that would take into account the diversity of the surrounding region and the uniqueness of the motoring population of each individual community.
