### Agency response

Kirksville is home to two major universities whose enrollment data is not totally reflected in the census figure. Truman State University and Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine account for an additional 6,000 students/residents (2009 numbers indicate that 19.3 of the Truman students are identified as other than white, and 96 percent come from outside Kirksville, including at least 309 international students). Kirksville is located on one of the few major north-south state highways (Highway 63) that service northern Missouri and southern Iowa. 8,700 vehicles per day travel the highway into and out of town. Kirksville is the largest city for miles and is the cultural/economic hub for a very large area. This expands the pool of those not counted in the city's census information.
