Brewers or their agents may sell or give away taps, vents or other vending equipment.

Dear Mr. Dampf:

This Department acknowledges receipt of your letter dated June 29, 1933, as follows:

"Will you kindly advise the undersigned if brewers or the distributing agents of the breweries can sell or give away taps and vents to fit beer kegs or if they can sell or give away any other beer vending equipment."

In an opinion issued by this office dated July 28, 1933, addressed to Dr. M. O. Raine, Food and Drug Supervisor, Jefferson City, Missouri, it was held that what is known as House Bill Number 23, or the Beer Bill, does not prevent brewers or their agents from selling or giving away taps, vents or other beer vending equipment.
