

The necessity of a permit when selling beer at picnic or fair grounds.

Dear Mr. Elmore:

Your letter of July 1st, requesting an opinion from this office is as follows:

"We are being asked if it is permissible for a customer, who has a permit to sell beer, to sell beer at a stand at these fairs or any place outside of his place of business. Will you please inform us on this question and if it can be done, how should he proceed?"

It is our opinion that under the recent beer law a permit to sell beer authorized under that act cannot be used as a roving permit authorizing the holder to sell at any other place of business than the place designated at the time the permit was taken out. One wishing to sell beer at a Park or Fair Grounds should apply for a permit to sell at that location.
