We have your request of December 29, 1934
for an opinion upon the following:

"Does the State Labor and Industrial Inspection Department have the authority to regulate fee charging employment agencies as set forth in Sections 13190 to 13193 inclusive R. S. Mo. 1929 by requiring reports and other information from them?"

We have made a very diligent study of the statutes involved in this matter and have examined other statutes relating to your department, but we are unable to find any statutory authority requiring employment agencies charging a fee to submit reports or other information to you.
