Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge receipt of your request
for an opinion, which reads as follows:

"I want to submit a question to
your office.

Where a person has a place of
business and is selling five per
cent beer and also operates
therein a pool table, the pool
table is not concealed by blinds
or a partition but is in plain
sight, is this a violation of
the liquor laws?"

A careful review of the State Liquor Control Act
fails to show any prohibition against the selling of five per
cent. beer in a place of business wherein a pool table is
operated. It is, therefore, the opinion of this department
that the State Liquor Control Act does not prohibit the sell-
ing of five per cent. beer in a place of business in which a
pool table is kept and operated.
