Dear Sir:

We have received your letter of July 15th, in which you enclosed the original and one copy of the proposed Articles of Association of the Public Mutual Casualty Company. We have examined the said Articles and we find the same to be in accordance with the provisions of Article 7, of Chapter 37, R. S. Missouri, 1929, and not inconsistent with the Constitution and Laws of the State and of the United States.

We observe, however, that there is no declaration of intention to form the company attached to the said Articles. Probably the same is on file in the Insurance Department, as is required by Section 5797, R. S. Missouri, 1929. We note also that the proof of publication shows that the declaration of notice of intention to form a company was published, and consequently the said declaration of notice must have been on file as is required. If so, then the incorporators would have likewise complied with the laws in this particular, although we have no knowledge as to whether or not this was done.

We are returning herein the original Articles of Association.
