Dear Mr. Leggett:

This office acknowledges receipt of your assistant Counsel's letter of recent date transmitting an executed copy of declaration of intention of original incorporators to form a joint stock life insurance company under the applicable provisions of Chapter 376, RSMo. 1949, together with proof of publication of such declaration of intention as required by law. The name proposed for such company is Old Security Life Insurance Company.

The documents referred to in the preceding paragraph have been examined and it appears that Section 376.370, RSMo. 1949, has been inadvertently referred to, whereas a correct reference would have been to Section 376.670, RSMo. 1949. It is the opinion of this office that such reference is inconsequential when viewed in the light of the company being formed under applicable provisions of Chapter 376, RSMo. 1949, and such documents are found to be in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 376, RSMo. 1949, and not inconsistent with the Constitution and laws of this State, and of the United States.
