Dear Mr. Duggins:

Receipt is acknowledged of your letter of April 9, 1964, submitting to this office an executed copy of Declaration of Intention of original incorporators of the proposed Ozark National Life Insurance Company, including a copy of the Articles of Incorporation of such corporation, to be formed under the provisions of Chapter 376 RSMo 1959, as amended. Also forwarded with your request for an opinion concerning the documents heretofore referred to was proof of publication of the same as required by Section 376.070 RSMo 1959.

An examination of the documents referred to in the preceding paragraph has been made as required by Section 376.070 RSMo 1959, and it is the opinion of this office that the same are found to be in accordance with the provisions of Sections 376.010 to 376.670 RSMo 1959, as amended, and not inconsistent with the Constitution and laws of this State and the United States.
