Dear Mr. Scharz:

By letter dated April 28, 1966, you request an opinion from this office as to whether documents submitted by National General Insurance Company are in accordance with Chapter 379 of the Statutes and are not inconsistent with the Constitution and laws of the state and the United States. These documents consist of photo-copies of the Declaration of Intention of the incorporators of National General Insurance Company, the Articles of Incorporation of such corporation to be formed under the provisions of Chapter 379, RSMo 1959, and the publisher's affidavit as to publication of said Articles as required by section 379.030 and 379.040, RSMo 1959.

An examination of the documents referred to in the preceding paragraph has been made as required by section 379.040, RSMo 1959, and the documents aforesaid are found by this office to be in accordance with the provisions of sections 379.010 through 379.160, and not inconsistent with the Constitution and laws of this state and the United States.
