Dear Secretary Kander:

This opinion letter responds to your request dated April 3, 2014, for our review under § 116.334, RSMo, of a proposed summary statement prepared for the petition submitted by Khristine Heisinger regarding a proposed amendment to amend Chapters 149 and 196, Revised Statutes of Missouri (2014-129). The proposed summary statement is as follows:

Shall Missouri law be amended to:

- create a tax on cigarettes and roll-your-own tobacco; and
- repeal the statutory requirements regarding the Tobacco Master Settlement Agreement between Missouri and certain tobacco product manufacturers?

Pursuant to § 116.334, RSMo, we approve the legal content and form of the proposed statement. Because our review of the statement is mandated by statute, no action that we take with respect to such review should be
