OPINION LETTER NO. 256-2016

Dear Secretary Kander:

This opinion letter responds to your request dated December 13, 2016, for our review under § 116.332, RSMo, of the sufficiency as to form of an initiative petition to amend Article I of the Missouri Constitution submitted by Mike Louis, version 10 (2018-102).

We approve the petition as to form, but § 116.332 gives the Secretary of State final authority to approve or reject the petition. Therefore, our approval of the form of the petition does not preclude you from rejecting the petition.

Although we do not suggest it is a basis for rejection at the time of our review, we note that this initiative petition includes a blank line on the signature sheet that must be replaced with the name of the secretary of state at the time the petition is circulated for voters. John (Jay) Ashcroft will be the Missouri Secretary of State when this sheet is distributed to voters.

Because our review of the petition is simply for the purpose of determining sufficiency as to form, the fact that we do not reject the petition is not to be construed as a determination that the petition is sufficient as to substance. Likewise, because our review is mandated by statute, no action The Honorable Jason Kander Page 2

that we take with respect to such review should be construed as an endorsement of the petition or of the objectives of its proponents, or the expression of any view respecting the adequacy or inadequacy of the petition generally.
