Dear Secretary Ashcroft:

This opinion letter responds to your request dated March 1, 2017, for our review under § 116.334, RSMo, of a proposed summary statement prepared for the petition submitted by Marc Ellinger regarding a proposed constitutional amendment to amend Article IV of the Missouri Constitution, version 1 (2018-137). The proposed summary statement is as follows:


Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to redefine the current definition of hunting and restrict hunting as expressly referenced in this provision of the Constitution, which prohibits the killing of confined big game (such as deer including elk and moose, wild pigs including peccary, bighorn sheep, and other hooved animals); prohibits the importing of big-game species into Missouri except for public zoos, wildlife organizations, or for scientific research; and gives the Missouri Conservation Commission primary regulatory authority over privately owned big-game species?

Pursuant to § 116.334, RSMo, we approve the legal content and form of the proposed statement. Because our review of the statement is mandated by

statute, no action that we take with respect to such review should be construed as an endorsement of the petition, nor as the expression of any view regarding the objectives of its proponents.
