Dear Secretary Ashcroft:

This opinion letter responds to your request dated May 5, 2017, for our review under § 116.334, RSMo, of a proposed summary statement prepared for the petition submitted by Wayne Baker regarding a proposed constitutional amendment to amend Article IV of the Missouri Constitution, version 2 (2018-220). The proposed summary statement is as follows:

Do you want to amend the Missouri Constitution to:


- require that all government owned roads currently in existence shall be public and not subject to the payment of any toll for their use; and
- prohibit the highways and transportation commission from transferring all or part of a non-tolled road to another entity as a toll project?

Pursuant to § 116.334, RSMo, we approve the legal content and form of the proposed statement. Because our review of the statement is mandated by statute, no action that we take with respect to such review should be
