1. All emails Board of Education President Jonathan Russell received from or sent to an email address ending in @mosba.org between July 1, 2021 and August 31, 2021.
2. All emails sent or received by Board of Education President Jonathan Russell since January 1, 2021 containing the terms "critical race theory," "CRT," or "equity."

I request these records in an electronic format if that format is available.

These requests seek documents that are in the public interest because they are likely to contribute to a better understanding of the operations or activities of Neosho School District. In addition, this is not a request for commercial purposes. For these reasons, pursuant to § 610.026.1(1), RSMo, the Missouri Attorney General's Office requests a waiver of any fees associated with processing this request for records. If that waiver is not granted, please provide an estimate of the cost.
