Dear Secretary Ashcroft:

This opinion letter responds to your request dated February 9, 2023, for our review under § 116.334, RSMo of a proposed summary statement prepared for the petition submitted by Lisa D'Souza, 2024-030. The proposed summary statement is as follows:

Do you want to amend Missouri law to:

- require employers, beginning May 1, 2025, with fifteen or more employees provide one hour of paid sick leave for every thirty hours worked, using no more than forty hours annually;
- require employers with fewer than fifteen employees provide the same paid sick leave, using no more than twenty-four hours annually;
- allow up to 80 hours of earned sick time to carry over annually;
- allow the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations to provide oversight and enforcement; and
- exempt governmental entities, political subdivisions, school districts, education institutions and some specific construction employees?

Pursuant to § 116.334, RSMo, we approve the legal content and form of the proposed statement. Because our review of the statement is mandated by statute, no action that we take with respect to such review should be construed as an endorsement of the petition, nor as the expression of any view regarding the objectives of its proponents.
