OPINION LETTER NO. 401-2023

Dear Secretary Ashcroft:

This opinion letter responds to your request dated October 18, 2023, for our review under § 116.334, RSMo of a proposed summary statement prepared for the petition submitted by Greta Bax, 2024-141. The proposed summary statement is as follows:

Do you want to amend the Missouri Constitution to:

- remove a person's current statutory right to conceal and carry a firearm without a permit;
- make it a class E Felony for any person who conceals and carries a firearm without a permit from the county sheriff where they reside;
- require all applicants to pass a background check, be at least eighteen years of age and complete firearms safety training;
- require persons to carry the permit and if not, may be issued a citation up to fifty dollars; and
- allow sheriffs to charge a permit fee up to one hundred dollars?

Pursuant to § 116.334, RSMo, we approve the legal content and form of the proposed statement. Because our review of the statement is mandated by statute, no action that we take with respect to such review should be construed as an endorsement of the petition, nor as the expression of any view regarding the objectives of its proponents.
