Dear Secretary Ashcroft:

This opinion letter responds to your request dated December 21, 2022 for our review under § 116.334, RSMo of a proposed summary statement prepared for the petition submitted by Winston Apple, 2024-004. The proposed summary statement is as follows:

Do you want to amend the Missouri Constitution to:

- allow members of the general assembly to acquire proxies from eligible Missouri voters to vote on all matters; require the governor to establish, maintain, and ensure the security and privacy of an online system for voters to facilitate electronically assigning and reassigning of proxies;
- allow a simple majority of votes instead of two-thirds to override a gubernatorial veto;
- require the general assembly to pass legislation providing penalties for proxy malfeasance; and
- elect members of the general assembly on November 3, 2026 based on assignment of the most proxies per district?

Pursuant to § 116.334, RSMo, we approve the legal content and form of the proposed statement. Because our review of the statement is mandated by statute, no action that we take with respect to such review should be construed as an endorsement of the petition, nor as the expression of any view regarding the objectives of its proponents.
