This representation was false or misleading as to Defendant's intention or ability to perform the promise or the likelihood the promise would be performed.

The range punishment for a class E felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than one (1) year and not to exceed four (4) years; or by imprisonment for a special term not to exceed one (1) year in the county jail or other authorized penal institution; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the

commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.

years of age or older and Defendant made a false pretense that defendant would replace the retaining wall at the residence for \$22,974.98 to induce to enter into an agreement by promising performance the defendant did not intend to perform or knew would not be performed, and thereby knowingly obtained control of monies, property of with a value of at least five thousand dollars, with the intent to permanently deprive of the use of the property, and thereby detrimentally affected
The range punishment for a class C felony is imprisonment in the custody of the Missouri Department of Corrections for a term of years not less than three (3) years and not to exceed ten (10) years; or by a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or by both imprisonment and a fine. If money or property has been gained through the commission of the crime, any fine imposed may be not more than double the amount of the offender's gain from the commission of the crime.
