PETITION FOR REVIEW

Under Clean Air Act § 3071(b)(1) (42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1)), 5 U.S.C. §§ 702 and 706, Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 15(a), and D.C. Circuit Local Rule 15, the States of West Virginia, Oklahoma, Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, Georgia, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia, and Wyoming, along with the Arizona Legislature and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, petition this Court for review of the final agency action taken by Respondents United States Environmental Protection Agency and Michael S. Regan, Administrator, United States Environmental Protection Agency, entitled "Adoption and Submittal of State Plans for Designated Facilities: Implementing Regulations Under Clean Air Act Section 111(d)," 88 Fed. Reg. 80480 (Nov. 17, 2023). Petitioners have attached a copy of that final rule.

Petitioners will show that the final rule exceeds the agency's statutory authority and otherwise is arbitrary, capricious, an abuse of discretion, and not in accordance with law. Petitioners thus ask that this Court declare unlawful and vacate the Administrator's final action.
