The Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU) is a team of investigators, medical professionals, and legal experts dedicated to uncovering and prosecuting healthcare fraud and patient abuse or neglect. They work to protect vulnerable individuals and safeguard taxpayer dollars through extensive investigations and legal action across Missouri.



WHAT IS MEDICAID FRAUD?

Fraud occurs when a provider bills for services not provided or misrepresents services to receive unjust Medicaid payments.

Common Fraud Schemes:

- · Billing for services not provided
- Double billing for the same patient/procedure/date
- Falsifying claim information
- Substituting generic drugs but billing for brandname
- Billing for unnecessary or more expensive services
- Kickbacks (payments exchanged for referrals or services)

Providers Investigated:

Doctors, dentists, hospitals, nursing homes, pharmacies, clinics, counselors, personal care service companies, and others.

PATIENT ABUSE OR NEGLECT

The MFCU investigates abuse and neglect of patients in Medicaid-funded facilities (e.g., nursing homes and hospitals). This includes:

- Physical harm intentionally caused by staff
- Neglect, such as failing to provide necessary medical care
- Misuse of a patient's private funds

REPORTING FRAUD, ABUSE, OR NEGLECT
