Dear Sir:

In answer to your request of July 7, 1938, submitting to this office the initiative petition containing proposal to amend various sections of Article IV of the Constitution, we submit herewith the following as a valid title for said measure in accordance with Section 10706 R. S. Missouri 1929:

> "Proposed constitutional amendment relating to legislative proceedings, apportionment of senators and representatives, their qualifications, election, compensation, tenure, redistricting, limiting number of legislative employees, creating Statute and Revision Commission, home loan bank, authorizing bond issue, allocating onethird of revenue to schools, two per cent to state parks, requiring 35,000 miles of rural roads, providing for granting public moneys, for pensioning firemen, their widows and children, the blind, and persons over sixty-five years, and providing the initiative and referendum except as to public matters declared to be an emergency by the legislature and authorizing the earmarking of taxes for special purposes."
