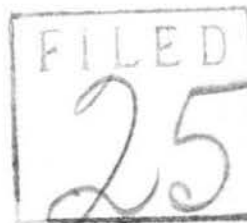

This is to acknowledge your letter dated December 11, 1936, wherein you enclose a copy of proposed Articles of Agreement of "Medical Guild Service, Inc.," and you desire our opinion of approval of said Articles.

If the court enters a pro forma decree of incorporation along the same plan stated in the Articles of Agreement of Medical Guild Service, Inc., as attached to your letter and retained in our files, in our opinion, it would be a legal incorporation under Article 10, Chapter 32, R. S. Mo. 1929.

It is our further opinion that said proposed plan, if incorporated by a pro forma decree, would not be a cooperative company within the purview and meaning of Article 9 of Chapter 32, R. S. Mo. 1929.
