

INSURANCE: Amendment to Declaration of State National Life Insurance Company valid.

Dear Sir:

This department is in receipt of your letter of April 14th, requesting an opinion as to the validity of an amendment of the "Declaration of Intention of Corporators to Form Joint Stock Company" of the State National Life Insurance Company, St. Louis, Missouri.

We have examined this amendment and find that the same is in accordance with the provisions of Article II, Section 37, Revised Statutes of Missouri 1929, and not inconsistent with the Constitution and Laws of this State and the United States. In this connection, we assume that the special meeting of the stockholders held on September 18, 1934, and the annual meeting of the stockholders held on March 2, 1937, were duly called and held.
