Dear Mr. Rose:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter of recent date in which you request an opinion of this office; which letter is as follows:

"As the prosecuting attorney elect of Putnam county I have been asked about the legality of holding dances on Sunday night, which would not be affected by municipal ordinances. My judgment is that this is not a violation of the law. May I have your opinion?"

We do not find any criminal statute against the holding of dances on Sunday night. Of course, cities and towns could enact ordinances whereby reasonable regulations could be placed on public dances, but no statute prohibits holding dances on Sunday.
